

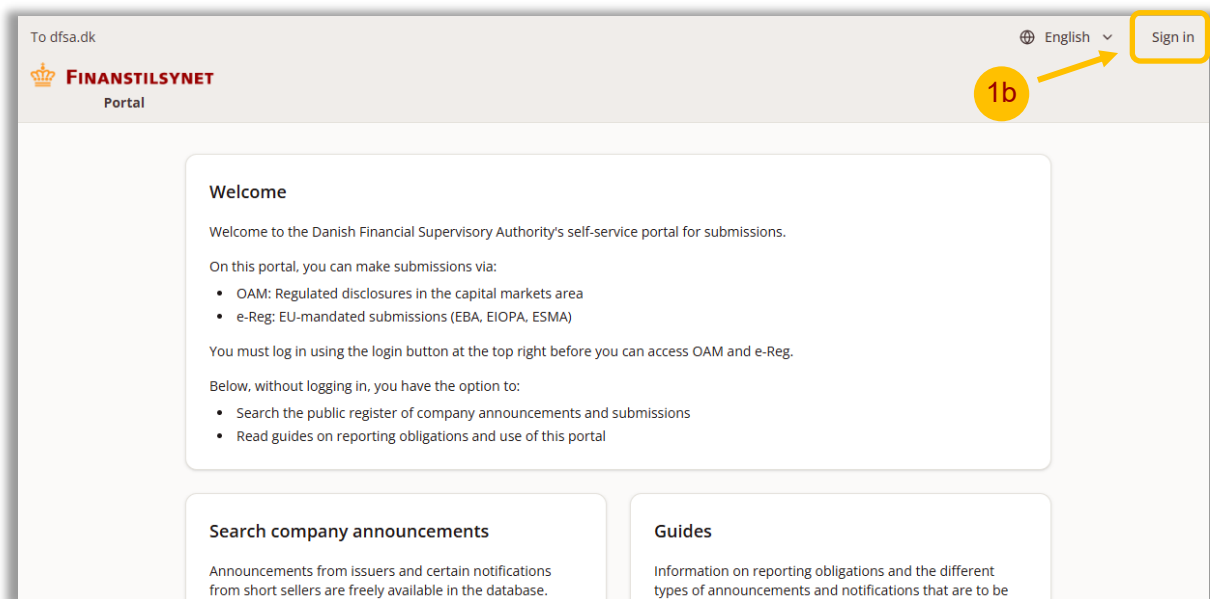
This is how you find the master data in your user account in the DK FSA's self service portal

This guide explains how, as an individual user, you can find the Master data on your user account in the Danish FSA's self-service portal. This information is required for the application form when applying for reporting rights to e-Reg.

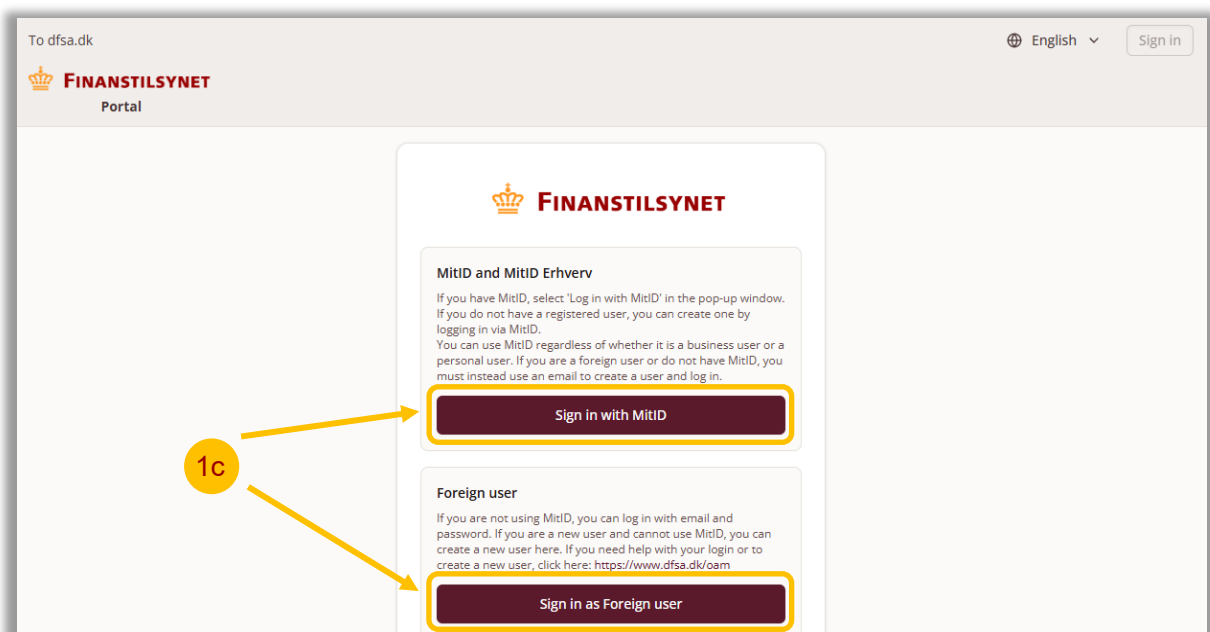
(1) Log in to the self service portal

(1a) Navigate to the Danish FSA's self-service portal via this link: <https://portal.finanstilsynet.dk/>

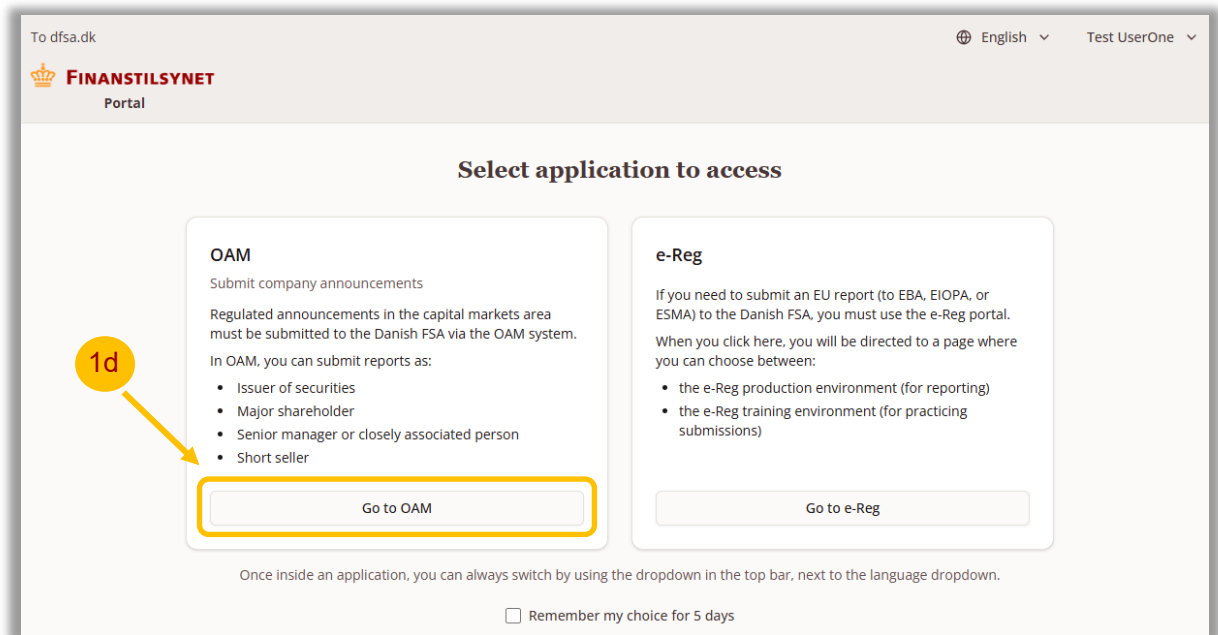
(1b) You will see the page shown below, where you should click on "Sign in" in the top right corner.



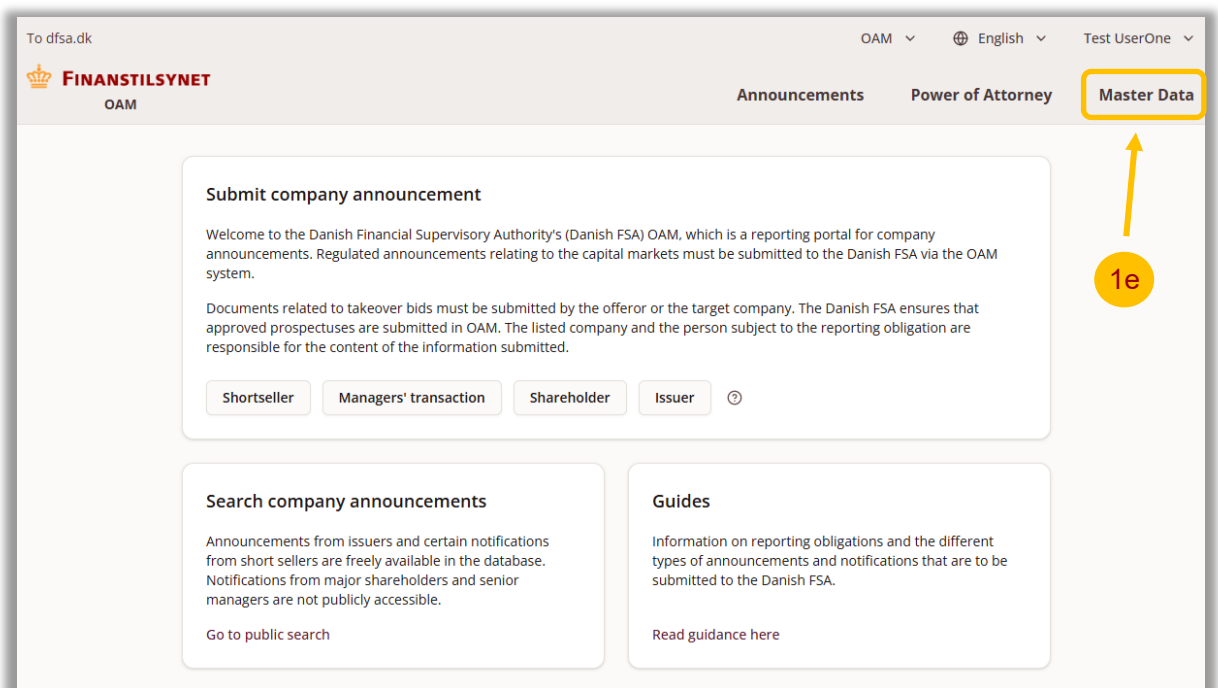
(1c) After you have clicked on "Sign in", you will be presented with the page shown below. Here, choose to log in using the login method you selected when your user account was created.



(1d) Once you are logged in, you will land on the page shown below. To access the section where you can view your master data, you need to click on “Go to OAM”.



(1e) On the next page, you need to click on “Master data”.



(1f) You are now on the master data page of your user account. Here you will find all the information you need to complete your application form when applying for reporting rights in e-Reg.

(1fa) You will find your **user ID** under the section “Your user profile” in the field “Unique ID”.

(1fb) You will find your **first name** under the section “Your user profile” in the field “Your names”. On the e-Reg reporting rights application form, you need to state your first name separately from your last name.

(1fc) You will find your **last name** under the section “Your user profile” in the field “Your names”. On the e-Reg reporting rights application form, you need to state your last name separately from your first name.

(1fd) You will find your **e-mail** address under the section “Your user profile” in the field “Email”.
